HOW DOES A MOBILE APP FIGHT FOOD INSECURITY?

1 Helps users find nearby food resources

Interactive Map: find nearby food pantries, food shelves, community meals and resource offices. Including hours, contact info, feedback tools and photos.

Push Notifications: about mobile food pantries, events, and new locations

SNAP Action Center: To get (re)started with SNAP

2 Provides users with ways to help our efforts

Sign up to volunteer and find volunteer opportunities

Donate food or funds

Send Feedback on food shelves

3 Generates useful data that is otherwise unavailable

- Same-household over time
- By county, zip and household over time
- Low-cost, self-reporting tool that can be correlated with major household changes, language, and income levels
- USDA food insecurity reporting
- Respects privacy: without having to ask for personally-identifiable information
- Compiled continuously, for real-time snapshots
